INVITATION FOR BIDS PROPOSAL NO. 2927

TRAFFIC MARKING MATERIALS (DELIVERED)

Notice is hereby given that the Commission of Limestone County, Alabama will receive competitive bids on the following items:

TRAFFIC MARKING MATERIALS (DELIVERED) SEE ATTACHED SPECIFICATIONS.

This bid is effective from October 1, 2026, until September 30, 2027.

Date of Delivery: **AS REQUESTED.** Terms: **NET 30 DAYS.**

You are invited to bid on the attached specifications. Any substitutes offered must be submitted in detail. The right to reject any items or materials not of quality or under any provisions of applicable Alabama law is reserved.

Proposals must be received by 10:00 a.m., CST, on Tuesday, September 10, 2026. Late proposals shall not be considered. Deliver sealed proposals by hand, U.S. Mail, or commercial courier service to:

Fax and/or electronically delivered (e.g., by email) proposals shall not be accepted.

Bids will be opened on **Thursday**, the 10th day of **September 2026**, at **10:00 a.m.** and awarded on **Monday**, the 21st day of **September 2026**, at the regular meeting of the Limestone County Commission, which will follow a work session at **9:00 a.m.**

REQUIREMENTS:

SECTION 1: GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1.1 Bid Package: All Bids must be clearly marked on the outside of a sealed envelope **“Traffic Marking Materials (Delivered).”** Further, the outside of the envelope shall also be clearly marked with the **proposal number and opening date.**

1.2 Award: Award will be made to the most responsive, responsible bid meeting specifications, which presents the product and/or service which is in the best interest of Limestone County. Limestone County reserves the right to reject any or all bids for any reason. Limestone County reserves the right to award each type of material listed in Attachment 1 to a separate bidder or award all types of the materials to one bidder. Bidder shall bid its prices for each material using Attachment 1, which is attached to this Invitation for Bids. Bidder must provide prices for each category of material listed in Attachment 1 or its bid may be determined to be non-compliant with this Invitation for Bids. All applicable taxes must be included in the amount of bid price.

1.3 Copies: Limestone County requires that bids be submitted with 1 original and 5 copies.

1.4 Signing of Bids: In order to be considered, all bids must be signed by an officer of the bidding company.

1.5 Contractor Default: Limestone County reserves the right, in the case of Bidder default under an awarded bid, to procure the articles or services from other sources and hold the defaulting vendor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.

1.6 Waiving of Informalities: Limestone County reserves the right to waive informalities or technicalities in any bids when in the best interest of Limestone County.

SECTION 2: OBLIGATIONS, RIGHTS, AND REMEDIES

2.1 Alterations and Amendments: No alterations, amendments, changes, modifications, or additions to this request shall be binding on Limestone County without the prior written approval of the County.

2.2 Compliance with all Laws: Bidder is assumed to be familiar with and agrees to observe and comply with all federal, state, and local laws, statutes, ordinances, and regulations in any manner affecting the provision of goods and/or services, and all instructions and prohibitive orders issued regarding this work. Bidder shall provide proof of appropriate licensing and permits in the State of Alabama upon request. If Bidder's Bid is awarded, then Bidder shall make all reports, as necessary, to any and all federal, state, and local entities, if and as required.

2.3 Governing Laws: The laws of the State of Alabama shall govern this Invitation for Bids, and all obligations of the parties will be performable in Limestone County, Alabama. The courts of Limestone County, Alabama, shall have jurisdiction over any disputes which arise hereunder

and the courts in such jurisdiction shall be the exclusive venue for any claims, suits, or actions by either party.

2.4 Indemnification/Hold Harmless: The Bidder who is awarded a contract for the provision of the described services and/or goods, shall indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless the Limestone County Commission, its officers, agents, and employees from all suits, claims, actions or damages of any nature brought because of, arising out of, or due to breach of the awarded contract, its subcontractors, suppliers, agents, or employees, or due to any negligent act or occurrence, or any omission or commission of Bidder, its subcontractors, suppliers, agents or employees.

2.5 Nondiscrimination and Statement: Bidder agrees that no person on the grounds of handicap, age, race, color, religion, sex, or national origin, shall be excluded from participation in, or be denied benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination in the performance of any contract awarded pursuant to this request, or in the employment practices of Bidder.

SECTION 3: SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

3.1 Intent: The Limestone County Commission is requesting bids from interested and qualified vendors for providing Traffic Marking Materials (Delivered) to the Limestone County Commission which meets the specifications in this Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, all related requirements set forth in this Invitation for Bids and this Section 3.

3.2 Term: The effective term of the awarded bid is from October 1, 2026, to September 30, 2027.

3.3 Compliance with All Applicable Regulations: The successful Bidder agrees and covenants that the company, its agents and employees will comply with all codes, laws, rules, and regulations applicable to the business conducted pursuant to any awarded bid.

3.4 Delivery of Services: Bidder shall deliver all goods and/or services as described in this Invitation for Bids, including, but not limited to, in the attachment(s) to this Invitation for Bids. Limestone County reserves the right to reject any non-conforming materials.

3.5 Specifications on Traffic Marking Materials (Delivered):

TRAFFIC MARKING MATERIALS - All materials shall meet the most recent applicable section of the Alabama Department of Transportation Specifications for Traffic Marking Materials and any ALDOT Special Provisions which may supersede this publication. Materials shall meet criteria in the ALDOT Special and Standard Drawings, latest edition and/or be approved by the purchasing County Engineer. Materials shall be supplied by same vendor at time of order.

All Paint Types Bulk Intermediate Bulk Container (IBC):

1. Shall be designed to accommodate lifting and transporting with four-way pallet forklift, pallet jack handling, or frontend loader.
2. Shall be capable of being stacked a minimum of two high when filled with paint.
3. Shall have a security feature that protects the valve from being opened by accident or by vandals.

4. Shall be 100% compatible with waterborne paint.
5. Shall have proper venting of the tank by either vacuum relief valve or having an access port that can be opened. Opening the container for vacuum relief shall not cause the paint to come into direct contact with the air.
6. No re-used IBC from cleaning allowed.
7. Shall be blow molded bottle with tubular galvanized steel cage.
8. Pallet: 4-way plastic or wood "block" style pallet.
9. All prices delivered to Limestone County or F.O.B. job site within that County.
10. The minimum order for IBC shall be a cumulative of 11 Containers.

The minimum gallons per (IBC) Container shall be 250.

3.6 Anti-Boycott Requirements: Bidder avers that it is not currently engaged in, and during the duration of any agreement with Limestone County shall not engage in, the boycott of any person or entity based in or doing business with a jurisdiction with which Alabama can enjoy open trade. If bid is awarded, then Bidder shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with Act 2016-312, as provided to it by Limestone County.

3.7 Anti-Economic Boycotts Requirements: If Bidder is a company with 10 or more full-time employees, the Bidder avers that, without violating controlling law and when not excepted by Alabama Code (1975) § 41-16-161(c), it does not, and shall not during the duration of any agreement between it and Limestone County, engage in economic boycotts. If awarded a contract pursuant to this request, then Bidder (if a company with 10 or more full-time employees) shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with Act 2023-409, as provided to it by Limestone County.

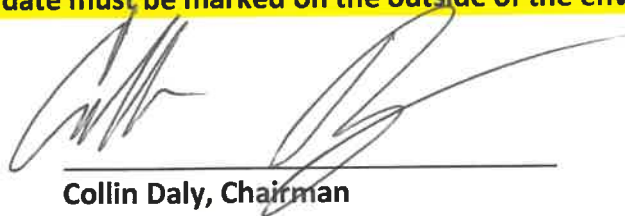
3.8 Beason-Hammon Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act Requirements: By submitting a Bid and/or by entering into an agreement with Limestone County pursuant to an award based on this Invitation for Bids, then Bidder affirms, for the duration of any such agreement, that it will not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. Furthermore, a party found to be in violation of this provision shall be deemed in breach of the agreement formed and shall be responsible for all damages resulting therefrom. Moreover, Bidder shall provide documentary proof to Limestone County that it participates in the E-Verify program. If the Bid submitted pursuant to this Invitation for Bids is awarded by Limestone County, then Bidder shall complete and execute a Certificate of Compliance with the Beason-Hammon Alabama Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, as provided to it by Limestone County.

SECTION 4: COMPANY INFORMATION
