MINUTES, LIMESTONE COUNTY COMMISSION, MARCH 1, 2021 WORK SESSION

The Limestone County Commission reconvened the meeting from February 22, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. today at the Clinton Street Courthouse Annex, 100 South Clinton Street, Athens, Alabama.
